


## Welcome to our May 2025 Newsletter

There is concern over the **decline** in the number of **ducks** here in the UK. The winter population of **mallards** has dropped by **36%** since 1995 but the cause is not known. Essex Uni. is doing **research** into why. Despite being our most common duck there has been very little research in recent decades. We are **so pleased** that Helen, one of our future **hedge recipients**, has **3 wild ducks** sitting on her land by the river.



**SFT** had a good morning **infilling the hedge** at the football club with the rest of the Greenwood hedge plants. **Many thanks** for their **support**. This is what we are aiming for; such **wonderful blossom** this spring.



**Derek Crush** is hoping his **turtle doves** will return this year to Daylands Farm, despite the EU **lifting the ban** on shooting them for sport. They like **tall**, **uncut**, **untidy hedges** perhaps with Old Man's Beard (Clematis). A **pond** for water with easy access sloping sides and a supply of their favourite food plants nearby.
